A. no decision. But it could be done as part of the migration then no need for backwards compatibility.

Q. If there was a clear decision on whether the xml or the database is used then the enforcer would not need to understand adapters. This will be thought about some more.

Currently the enforcerNG has no "add zone" command; we need to decide if it is required or not.

Users don't like editing xml so command line is probably preferable; then we need a sync / backup command. Currently we have confusion about whether the xml or the database is the master...

Tried to get a student to visualise the state changes, but there was no interest. So Yuri wrote a python script to do the rollover and this may be able to become a graphical representation. Idea is for a page where you set your policy and a timeline of key rolls pops out.

Waiting for the design of the import/export of keystates to migrate from enforcer to enforcerNG.
